Please note, the H1N1 vaccine is now available for all NJ residents, however priority groups continue to be the following:

- Pregnant women;
- People who live with or provide care for infants younger than 6 months;
- Healthcare and emergency medical services personnel;
- All people from 6 months through 24 years of age, and;
- People 25 years through 64 years of age who have certain medical conditions that put them at higher risk for influenza-related complications.

PLEASE BE AWARE: Christ Hospital currently does not have the pediatric dosage used for children 6 months to 3 years of age. To obtain the pediatric vaccine, please call the Jersey City Department of Health at (201) 547-6800 or (201) 547-6806. Seasonal flu shots will not be available.

Only people over the age of 37 months will be able to receive the vaccine at Christ Hospital's upcoming H1N1 flu clinics.

For your safety, the following people should NOT get the injectable flu vaccine and are advised to follow up with a physician:

- People with severe (life-threatening) allergy to eggs, or to any other substance in the vaccine. Should you arrive at the clinic, please advise the nurse administering the vaccine if you have any severe allergies.
- People who have had a life-threatening allergic reaction after a dose of seasonal flu vaccine.
- People who are feeling sick and have a fever on the day they are to receive the shot are asked to delay vaccination until symptoms disappear.
- Tell the health care provider if you ever had Guillain-Barré Syndrome or GBS.
